

**Dollar amounts calculated on a bi-weekly pay schedule.*

\$1 per pay (\$26 annually):

- Buys a supply of groceries for a family during a financial crisis.
- Fills five backpacks with food to feed hungry children over the weekend.

\$2 per pay (\$52 annually):

- Provides a nutritious, home delivered meal to eight senior citizens.
- Buys 208 pounds of food for local food pantries and soup kitchens to distribute to those in need.

\$3 per pay (\$78 annually):

- Buys two hours of safety training classes to learn skills such as CPR and First Aid.
- Provides seven hours of after-school tutoring for an inner city youth.

\$4 per pay (\$104 annually):

- Buys two prescriptions for a underinsured or noninsured person in a medical emergency.
- Links eight callers in need with services that can help 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

\$5 per pay (\$130 annually):

- Provides three hours of job readiness training for an unskilled or underemployed individual.
- Provides two days of care for an adult with Alzheimer's or other aging-related dementia.

\$10 per pay (\$260 annually):

- Provides one week of daycare and therapy for a child living with disabilities.
- Provides one week in an emergency shelter for someone who is homeless.

\$20 per pay (\$520 annually):

- Provides eight hours of legal services for an adult or family in crisis.
- Provides 20 hours of safe and educational after-school programs and activities.

\$40 per pay (\$1,040 annually):

- Provides seven hours of emergency response services during or following a disaster.
- Provides two weeks of shelter and services for a victim of domestic violence.
