Effective March 2004

A donor may allocate 100% of their gift anyway they wish within the United Way of the Greater Dayton Area's network of services:

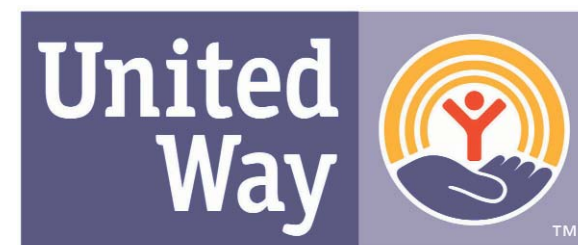
- **Community Solutions Fund**
- **Priority Areas**
- **Partner Agencies**

or to:

- **Another United Way**
- **Member agencies of our neighboring United Ways:**

(including Butler, Champaign, Clark, Clinton, Darke, Fayette, Madison, Miami and Warren counties in Ohio, and Wayne County in Indiana)

Individuals who wish to support the network of services and support a cause or agency important to them may also direct up to 50% of their total contribution to any 501(c)(3) organization that provides a health or human service in our region. This policy was created to provide a "win-win" for the donors and the community. It is based on an "and" not "or" approach - to maximize funds available for the community allocation process to support programs addressing priority needs, while also allowing donors to direct how their gifts will support local health and human services.
