are Issuing a Request for Proposals through a Joint Application
for the July 2012 – June 2014 Funding Cycle

Human Services Levy Supported Services Funds and United Way Live United Funds will be utilized to support selected proposals requesting funding for any or all health and human services or social services provided from as early as July 1, 2012 through and including June 30, 2014 to the residents of Montgomery County. Any proposed services must demonstrate their relationship to and support of:

- a) The Montgomery County Family and Children First Council's (FCFC's) **Community Outcomes, Targeted Indicators**, and/or current Outcome Team **Focus Areas**;
- b) The United Way of the Greater Dayton Area's (UWGDA) **Community Impact Agenda**;
- c) Or both

Selected proposals may be awarded up to a two-year agreement beginning as early as July 1, 2012 and ending no later than June 30, 2014 at the sole discretion of the Montgomery County Board of County Commissioners and United Way of the Greater Dayton Area.

Only completed proposals following the prescribed method of application including attendance at one of the MANDATORY Bidders Conferences sessions will be considered. No late proposals will be accepted or considered.
