



What your dollar buys...

Positive youth development

- \$12** buys one session of alcohol and drug prevention to encourage youth to make healthy choices.
- \$18** buys one structured activity for youth to keep them off the streets after school.
- \$26** buys one day of childcare to help a low-income parent work or attend school.
- \$96** buys a runaway youth a night of safe shelter, counseling, and support services to return home or find a stable and safe long-term place to live.

Financial Stability and Independence

- \$1** buys more than 3 pounds of food to help feed hungry families.
- \$13** buys one night of shelter to help a homeless family after a disaster or financial crisis.
- \$20** buys one hour of literacy instruction and services to help an adult learn to read.
- \$67** buys one hour of legal assistance to help a family deal with an eviction notice or other legal problems.
- \$387** buys help to prevent a family from losing their home to foreclosure.

Health and Well-Being

- \$4** buys a senior citizen a home delivered meal to help them remain in their own home.
- \$20** buys one hour of direct personal care for a homebound person living with disabilities.
- \$25** buys two emergency prescriptions for persons living without insurance coverage.
- \$48** buys one day of services and transportation for an adult living with disabilities.
- \$93** buys five hours of disaster preparedness planning and training for our local community.
